THE FOLLOWING IS AN IMPORTANT UPDATE ON DOT RETURN-TO DUTY

Direct Observation Requirement for DOT Return-to-duty and Follow-up tests Temporarily Delayed

The U.S. Court of Appeal for the D.C. Circuit has temporarily delayed the November 1st

Direct Observation (DO) requirement for DOT return-to-duty and follow-up tests. This is an "administrative stay" until the Court completes its review on the matter.

Therefore, DO for return-to-duty and follow-up testing will continue to be an employer option, rather than mandatory.

We will let you know when the Court makes a decision on the matter.

FROM THE MASS RMV WEBSITE- MAILINGS ELIMINATED

The RMV will no longer mail out the following materials to customers:

a. License renewal notices

b. Mass ID renewal notices

c. License reinstatement letters:

Letter sent to a licensed customer when his/her license is reinstated, provided that the license is still active

Letter sent to an unlicensed customer when his/her right to operate is reinstated

d.Registration reinstatement letters:

Letter sent to a person or corporation whose suspended registration has been reinstated

Letter sent to a person or corporation whose revoked registration has been reinstated

e.Vehicle Inspection reminder letters for vehicles that are overdue for inspection

f. Inspector license renewal notices

g.7D license renewal notices

h. Driver's Education Certificates

i. Junior Operator Brochures for parents (still available in branches)

j. Change of address labels (customers can create their own)
